## Online Environment of The Reading Badge – New Trends and Tendencies

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## Slovenian Reading Badge Society What (and Why) is a Reading Badge?

- The Reading Badge was initially a mentoring practice at the Prevalje primary school (a small city in the north of Slovenia). The movement was founded in the school year 1960/61 by Slovenian language professor Stanko Kotnik and author of youth literature Leopold Suhodolčan.
- The two of them turned the existing reading club into "The Competition for the Reading Badge", quite a challenging activity. They wanted to find an escape from school formalities. The expansion of all possible sports competitions encouraged them to introduce a new spiritual parallel.
- The idea of The Reading Badge came to Kotnik while he was reading a report about a similar form of literary education done by the Czechs. He grounded the new competition: *"It is a noble cultural competition where young people compete with their peers and themselves. They are awarded the winning badge for success but at the same time they feel enriched inside."*
- The movement's initiatives today bring together about 140,000 readers each year. Reading is supported by 7,000 mentors (this includes only primary schools)

   librarians, teachers and other experts, as well as authors and publishers; children are also encouraged to read by their families.
- The Reading Badge programs even transcend Slovenian borders to reach **Slovenian communities abroad**.
- The mission of the Reading Badge, supported by schools, libraries, and similar organizations, is to promote the lifelong development of reading culture and reading literacy.
- Due to its significant role in the national culture, the Reading Badge is listed by the National Register of Intangible Cultural Heritage.
- Slovenian Reading Badge Society is the NGO heading the Reading Badge movement in terms of professional guidance and organization.



# The main objectives of Slovenian Reading Badge Society

- **Provides guidelines** for the selection of reading materials and develops the tools needed for their use.
- Shares expert knowledge on the development of modern strategies for encouraging reading.
- Informs about the development of reading, writing and literary culture.
- Ensures efficient and quick integration of the network of participants and an unimpeded flow of information.
- Organizes programmes of specialized education and exchanges.
- Coordinates visits of Slovenian authors.
- **Provides** motivational **book gifts** and works to improve the quality of youth literature.
- Prepares motivational materials and certificates.
- **Develops** various **pilot programmes and projects** for different age groups (e.g. a programme of intergenerational reading, *Reading Tea Parties*).
- **Collaborates** with similar organizations in Slovenia and elsewhere (being one of the initiators of the *National Month of Reading Together* network; heading the *Reading Together* promotion programme, etc.).
- The Slovenian Reading Badge Society is **a member** of the Slovenian Association of Friends of Youth and is internationally active as a member of the Slovenian Section of IBBY and the Federation of European Literacy Associations.

## **Reading Badge online**

- The Reading Badge movement always tried to ٠ adapt to technological and social changes and strived to be modern.
- One of the tasks of our Society is updating the ٠ network of quality information and developing and directing different programme sets that take place throughout the Slovenian cultural space, in a unified movement with the goal of the development of reading culture.
- Our associates, members and mentors of reading, ٠ so-called professional promoters of reading, who are indispensable members of the Reading Badge movement, can keep up to date with events in the field of reading, books and reading culture with the help of an effective and frequently updated network for conveying quality information.

## Reading Badge during Covid-19 pandemic

We faced many challenges during the Covid-19 pandemic:

- How to continuously adapt the program content, as well as events that we organize in the field of reading culture, during lockdown?

- How to **encourage** young people **to read voluntarily** and to read books that match their interests during lockdown, when all family members are at home and bookstores and libraries are closed?

- How to **keep young readers and their parents interested** in reading and readingrelated activities and how to encourage the habit of reading among young readers and their parents?

- How to stay in touch with literature?

- How to keep reading mentors interested and motivated?



## Adjustements

• Adjustments for the acknowledgement of reading for the Reading Badge.

• Marko Kravos (president of Slovenian Reading Badge Society: *A Missive in 12 Syllables*: a special poetic communication during lockdown (via e-mail and web page).

• **Meetings with Slovenian authors** of youth literature: replace the connections with the authors with various forms of appearances in virtual form. Virtual meetings or meeting outside, in the open have become a reality and a constant practice.

• **Educational events:** all of our educational events in 2020 and 2021 have been moved into a virtual environment.

• Online Reading Tea Parties: two-hour long meetings on various topics related to the development of reading culture and the books/literature for children and young people.

• Intergenerational Reading: the groups connected online and successfully continued to meet.

• **MEGA quiz:** Collaboration with Pionirska - Center for Youth Literature and Librarianship; City Library Ljubljana In the time of homeschooling it turned out to be an excellent tool for the promotion of reading and for combining fun, learning and competition.







## Reading Badge after pandemic



• Some things have proven to be useful also for the time after the pandemic: online lectures are accessible to more people at a lesser cost; meetings of readers online are accessible from different places; there are advantages for the Slovenian communities abroad, ...

 Mentors appreciate the guidance, regular communication and suggestions for work adjustments. Judging by the responses, we made their work easier and more flexible with our directions.

## The Recommendation Room

- The Recommendation Room is a part of Reading Badge website and a unique way of presenting and promoting high quality (also nominated and awarded) children's and youth books.
- We started publishing presentations in the Recommendation Room in January 2015.
- All members of the Reading Badge Programme Committee can select and present books in the Recommendation Room. Most of the contributions are prepared by our vicepresident Tilka Jamnik, M.L.S., the most prominent promoter of reading youth literature in Slovenia.
- The design framework and system for providing data on individual presentations in the Recommendation Room are defined, and our work is based on data on youth literature production, as prepared by the Center for Youth Literature and Librarianship at the City Library Ljubljana. The selection of books and their content is always a matter of free reflection and decision of each contributor to the Recommendation Room.

- All presentations are primarily intended for professional readers, especially reading mentors. The recommendations of Tilka Jamnik, in particular, add valuable suggestions on how to motivate young people to read in the context of concrete literary works, how to deepen their understanding, how to open the way to other reading materials, and so on.
- The online form of the Recommendation Room **provides valuable links** between individual recommendations and links to other websites and online materials that further illuminate the selected book material.
- Compared to other selections of contemporary youth books (publisher presentations, blog posts, short presentations on FB...), the Recommendation Room distinguishes itself by its structured design, professional authors of recommendations, complex and well-thought-out proposals for motivating young readers and, last but not least, carefully designed search engine, which allows mentors to prepare short lists of books according to age groups, the type or genre of the text, the topic ...
- The presentations **support the creativity** of mentors and their focus on young readers. The mentors are encouraged to pay attention to the spontaneous responses of young people and their opinions, to invite them to further reading, research and pick-up activities. The recommendations **support** the development of imagination, playfulness and a relaxed attitude towards literature, and also act as **an invitation** to voluntary leisure reading (also to reading for the reading badge).


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

## Video materials

- In the last two years we have prepared some short promotional video content on our YouTube Channel. The videos can be used to motivate young people to read.
- Award of the Slovenian section of IBBY: In 2020, the Slovenian Reading Badge Society received the award of the Slovenian section of IBBY for outstanding achievements in the field of promotion of youth literature and reading. Because a live award ceremony was not possible, the Slovenian section of IBBY prepared a <u>short</u> <u>video presentation</u> about the Slovenian Reading Badge Society that can be used to inform different target groups about Reading Badge movement.
- In the following years, we want to keep preparing materials for various target audiences.



## Nominations and Awards for Youth Literature



The Main Slovenian Awards in the Field of Literature, Illustration and Comics for Young Readers

- As already stated before, one of the tasks of our Society is also **updating the network of quality information** so that our coworkers and reading mentors can **keep up to date** with events in the field of reading, books and reading culture.
- Nominations and awards for literature for young readers are also one of the important ways to promote reading and authors of youth literature.
- Announcements of nominations and award-winning books are regularly monitored and published on our website.
- They are also **linked** to the **Recommendation Room** and other online book presentations, so the reading mentors and/or young readers can further expand their knowledge about the selected books.



## Online Reading Tea Parties

- One of our important objectives is to **educate** mentors (teachers and librarians), parents and the whole community by organizing lectures and workshops with inventive teachers, librarians, supervisors and specialists in the field of youth literature.
- Almoust all of our educational events in past two years have been **moved** into a virtual environment.
- The events were very well received and evaluated.
- Based on these results and findings, we started organizing *Reading Tea Parties* twohour long meetings on various topics related to the development of reading culture and the books/literature for children and young people).
- The meetings are **dedicated** to presentations of:
- contemporary youth literature,
- modern methods for the development and promotion of reading culture and reading literacy,
- authors from the field of youth literature who often join our meeting,
- successful mentoring practices and direct work with young readers,
- nominations and awards for youth literature ...
- First eight online *Reading Tea Parties* were held from March to December 2021.
- Due to the great interest we have prepared another series of (eight) *Reading Tea Parties* in 2022, which will be conducted monthly via the ZOOM tool.
- In the school year 2022/2023 *Reading Tea Parties* are included in the system of professional training supported by the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport.



## The future

- The Reading Badge will live on, we will continue to build on tradition and constantly adapt to new challenges in the field of reading and the demands of social changes. Its mission, as well as liveliness and perseverance, proved itself again during its 60th birthday celebration (2020/2021) when **new forms of promoting** reading among young people, their mentors, parents and other educators were required due to the pandemic and lockdown.
- In addition to special education courses, meetings with authors and other live events, we will also continue:


-to be active on various **social media platforms** (Facebook, Instagram, YouTube Channel, ...);

-to **supplement** the range **of e-reading materials** and **e-resources**, as the Reading Badge is aware of the importance of in-depth reading of e-materials and the promotion of modern forms of literacy;

-to **organize virtual visits** of authors and **conduct** various **additional educational events** (seminars, symposiums, online "Reading Tea Parties") for reading mentors, on Zoom and in person ...

• The vibrant cooperation between readers, mentors and authors related to reading, literature, and books, which they did not want to give up even during the pandemic, reminded us how special and valuable our movement (and our projects) is.
